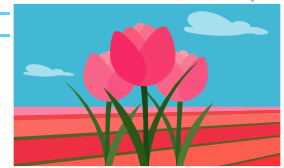

## Radiation Dispersal from Japan and the Effect on U.S. Workers

Efforts continue in Japan to contain the release of airborne radioactive contamination from the damaged Fukushima Daiichi power plant.

On March 17, 2011, President Obama, speaking outside the White House, stated "We do not expect harmful levels of radiation to reach the United States. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention do not recommend that people in the United States take precautionary measures beyond staying informed".

OSHA is working with other federal agencies to monitor domestic reports of radiation concerns and provide up-to-date worker protection information.

## Sleep Deprivation in the Workplace

Sleep deprivation is the condition of not having enough sleep. Excessive Sleepiness is the inability to consistently achieve the level of wakefulness needed to accomplish the tasks of daily living. Some physiological effects of lack of sleep are:

- Fatigue and daytime sleepiness
- Irritability
- Headaches
- Severe yawning
- Increased heart rate
- Increased blood pressure
- Decreased body temperature
- Cognitive impairment (ability to think and reason)
- Memory lapses or loss
- Aching muscles
- Growth suppression

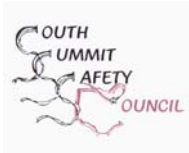
