August 10, 2011 Safety Council Meeting FRAUD and prevention

Wednesday, August 10, 2011 we will be meeting at Prime 93 for our second Safety Council meeting of the year. Our speaker will be Phillip J. Brickman, who currently serves as Special Agent in Charge of the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Northeast Regional Investigations Unit, serving 18 counties including the Cleveland, Akron, Canton, Mansfield and Youngstown areas. Mr. Brickman has successfully investigated hundreds of cases including several high profile cases in the Cleveland area. Mr. Brickman has specialized training in the area of covert electronics and is an adjunct instructor at the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) and the Ohio Highway Patrol (OHP). He is an active member of the National Technical Investigators Association—Mid Atlantic Chapter (MATIA) and the American Society of Law Enforcement Trainers (ASLET).

OSHA launches interactive Web site

OSHA has launched a web site to help employers better comply with its recordkeeping rules.

The OSHA Recordkeeping Advisor is an interactive tool that simulates an employer's interaction with a Recordkeeping Advisor relies on the users' responses to questions and automatically adapts to the situation presented. Responses put are strictly confidential and the system does not record or store any of the information. The Advisor helps employers determine:

- Whether an injury or illness (or related event) is work-related.
- Whether an event or exposure at home or on travel is work-related.
- Whether an exception applies to the injury or illness.
- Whether a work-related injury or illness needs to be recorded.
- Which provisions of the regulations apply when recording a work-related injury or illness.

"The Recordkeeping Advisor was developed to better help employers understand and comply with their responsibilities to report and record work-related injuries and illnesses," said Assistant Secretary of Labor for Occupational Safety and Health Dr. David Michaels.

Under the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970, employers are responsible for providing safe and healthful workplaces for their employees. OSHA's role is to assure these conditions for America's working men and women by setting and enforcing standards and providing training, education and assistance. Sleep Deprivation

- **ACUTELY** sleep deprived usually aware of the degree of impairment
- **CHRONICALLY** sleep deprived build up fatigue/attention lapses over time, so are equal in number and severity to lapses from acute sleep deprivation

Chronics may falsely conclude they are able to perform tasks that require constant attention when their abilities are actually impaired.

American Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM)

- 1 in 5 serious motor vehicle injuries related to driver fatigue
- 80,000 drivers falling asleep behind the wheel daily
- 250,000 accidents each year related to sleep

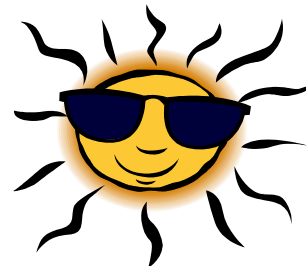

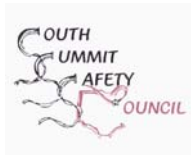
