Recycling Benefits for South Summit Chamber Members

Shelly Kadilak of SASWMA provided information with some great ways to “green up” and maybe save money in the process.

Because paper and cardboard make up a significant portion of most organizations waste stream (40%) and has value, she had mentioned that River Valley Paper Company, a local paper recycling company with 20 plus years of services, offers FREE recycling services to businesses.

Shelly reiterated the benefits of using their services and hoped that you may want to pass this information along to our members. River Valley Paper Company offers:

- FREE services for paper and cardboard recycling. They provide an outdoor recycling container and a pick-up service based on volume of material.
- They may include possible revenue sharing based on tonnage and material.
- Recycling paper and cardboard may save businesses money in waste hauling fees. Less trash=decrease in trash bill. Fiber (paper/cardboard makes up close to 40% of what is disposed of in your waste container.) If you recycle the paper & cardboard, the trash hauler will not need to service organizations as frequently which could lower your trash bill.

Each organization will need to provide a parking space and welcome the general public to use the recycling container as well.
