Milich's Village Inn commenced business in September of 1955. Mirko Milich and his wife Katie got into business by opening Hopocan Gardens in 1946 as a neighborhood tavern. Business was slow, so Katie Milich suggested they start serving chicken dinners. Katie had the background, having worked at Belgrade Gardens from the mid 1930's until the beginning of World War II. Katie was instrumental in the success of Hopocan Gardens as a restaurant and later in the development and success of Milich's Village Inn. Mirko purchased the property at 4444 S. Cleveland-Massillon Rd. and remodeled the building with his partner and son, Richard. They named the new restaurant Milich's Village Inn. Mirko and Katie's two other sons, Perry and Dale, also joined the family business and Richards wife, Sammie, also helped a great deal with the family business and worked without pay for a period of time. When the business started in 1955, the Milich Family served chicken dinners for \$1.00. The Milich's put an addition on the south side of the building to increase the seating capacity from 160 to 320 in 1958. Another renovation took place in 1961 increasing the size of the kitchen, adding to the north side of the building, which increased the seating to 420 and added an all glass foyer to the front of the building. Renovations and updates have been made to the restaurant almost every 7 years. Over the years, many young men and women have put themselves though college while working at the Village Inn and they are very proud of that reputation. Many of Milich's Village Inn employees are currently enrolled in local universities.

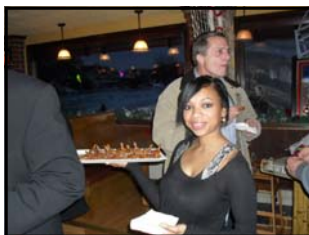
